Reading Area Community College is honored to present the 2025 President's Award, our institution's highest accolade, to Jim Boscov, the Boscov Family, and Boscov's Department Stores in recognition of their extraordinary commitment to the advancement of education, student success, and the mission of RACC.

The Boscov Family's enduring legacy of service and generosity has had a transformative impact on the life of the college and the futures of its students. Their contributions span decades and generations—marked by visionary leadership, philanthropic investment, and a profound belief in the power of education to uplift individuals and strengthen communities.

We begin by recognizing Shirley Holzman, whose dedicated service on the RACC Board of Trustees from 1980 to 1991 helped guide the college through a pivotal era. Her leadership was instrumental in the successful transition of sponsorship from the Reading School District to the County of Berks—a milestone that shaped the college's governance and ensured its long-term stability.

President Emeritus Dr. Gust Zogas, the esteemed third president of Reading Area Community College, passed away on August 25, 2024 at the age of 93. His remarkable leadership and dedication to education left an indelible mark on the institution and the community it serves.

Dr. Zogas assumed the presidency of Reading Area Community College in 1986 and served with distinction until 2002. During his tenure, the college experienced unprecedented growth, both in enrollment and in the expansion of its facilities. One of Dr. Zogas's most significant achievements was overseeing the transition

in sponsorship from the Reading School District to Berks County and the Board of Commissioners. This pivotal change paved the way for the college to reach new heights and fulfill its mission of providing quality education to all who sought it.

Dr. Zogas's legacy is deeply intertwined with the physical transformation of the college. He spearheaded the development of key facilities such as the Yocum Library, the Schmidt Training and Technology Center, and the Miller Center for the Arts, which have since become integral parts of the campus and the educational experience offered to students.

Notably, Dr. Zogas played a crucial role in establishing the college's endowment, which grew to become the second largest among Pennsylvania community colleges. His strategic vision and financial acumen ensured the long-term sustainability and prosperity of the institution, securing its legacy for generations to come.

Dr. Gust Zogas will be remembered not only for his professional accomplishments but also for his warmth, integrity, and deep commitment to the students, faculty, and staff of Reading Area Community College. His passing leaves a profound void in the hearts of all who had the privilege of knowing and working with him.

As we mourn the loss of a visionary leader and a true champion of education, we honor his life and legacy, grateful for the enduring impact he has had on the college and the community we serve. His spirit will continue to inspire us as we carry forward his legacy of excellence and dedication to learning.

IN MEMORIAM



James H. "Jim" Yocum, one of the beloved and impactful leaders in the history of Reading Area Community College, passed away at the age of 98 on April 8, 2025. His legacy is marked by his exceptional dedication to education, philanthropy, and service to his treasured Berks County community.

A lifelong advocate for higher education, Jim served as a Trustee of Reading Area Community College for 24 years, from July 1, 1991, through June 30, 2015. He demonstrated a steadfast commitment to the college and its students throughout his tenure. Jim's leadership was particularly evident in his roles as vice chairman from 1996 to 1998 and again from 2000 to 2002, as well as chairman from 1998 to 2000 and 2002 to 2004. His influence on the college's direction, growth, and success was immeasurable.

Jim was the driving force that established the Foundation for RACC in 1983. He served as the first chairman of the Foundation, established a remarkable 25 endowed Yocum Scholarships that have allowed hundreds of Berks County students earn a degree at Reading Area Community College. The Foundation for RACC, which Jim created, now has over 32 million dollars in assets, and stands as the second largest among all community colleges in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Jim also worked closely with his friends Dr. Gust Zogas and Marlin Miller to establish the Reading High School to Reading Area Community College Opportunity Scholarship Program that has provided tuition for hundreds of Reading High School students to attend Reading Area Community College.

Jim made a significant gift that allowed the Reading Area Community College leadership to build the first new building on the campus; a library. The Yocum Library has since served thousands of Reading Area Community College students, faculty, and staff. The Yocum Family Archives are also stored in the Yocum Library.

In recognition of his outstanding service, the Trustee Emeritus award was renamed to the James H. Yocum Trustee Emeritus award. Jim was honored as the first recipient of this prestigious designation.

Jim Yocum's contributions to Reading Area Community College will never be forgotten. Future generations of our students will be given the gift of a college education because of Jim Yocum's incredible generosity.

SIGNIFICANCE OF ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The history of academic attire dates far back into the days of the oldest universities. While European institutions continue to use great diversity in their specifications of academic dress, most American colleges and universities have adopted the academic dress standards of the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume.

Gowns: The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has oblong sleeves and may be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves and may be worn open or closed.

Gown Trimmings: There are no approved trimmings for the bachelor's or master's gown. The doctor's degree gown is faced down the front with black velvet with bars of velvet across the sleeves.

Stoles of Gratitude: The red Stoles of Gratitude, worn by each graduate, are a gift from the Student Government Association. These stoles may be used as gifts of gratitude for someone who has made a difference in the students' time at RACC and helped them achieve graduation. Some graduates may have chosen to write a personal note on it to present to someone, or keep it for themselves as a memento of their hard work at RACC.

Tribute Stole: The Tribute Stole is to recognize and honor those men and women who have served our country. The Tribute stole will be worn at graduation to honor those that have served.

First Generation Stole: These white stoles recognize those who are the first in their family to graduate from college. It is a symbol of hope for future generations and a celebration of perserverence of first-generation students.

SYMBOLS OF OFFICE



The Mace

The mace was initially modeled after a war club, useful objects for 12th-century officers whose main task was keeping order. A formidable weapon, the Mace was held ready to protect the person of the dignitary. Since the 16th-century in England and since colonial days in America, it has become a symbol of office only and is carried by a distinguished member of a faculty. The Reading Area Community College Mace is a fine piece of Eastern Pennsylvania black walnut grown in Berks County. It was turned on the lathes in the Department of the Physical Plant by former College employee, James Diener.



Presidential Medallion

The Reading Area Community College seal utilizes the Yocum Library as the central element because of its significance as the first original building constructed for the campus. The Yocum Library also serves as a focal point along the Schuylkill River and as a landmark entering the City of Reading. The Penn Street Bridge incorporates the physicality of Reading Area Community College and also symbolically represents the avenue of success and transition provided by higher education. The medallion was crafted by Peter Hoffman, an instructor in the computerized machine tool technology program at the Berks Career & Technology Center - West.



Presidential Chair

The first Presidential Chair was presented to Dr. Richard A. Kratz, fourth president of Reading Area Community College, on October 13, 2003 at his installation ceremony. The chair is used as the official seating for the President at all College ceremonies.


