SCHOOL	AGREEMENT
Albright College	<p>Guaranteed Transfer Admissions agreement facilitates the transfer of RACC students who have completed the RACC Associate of Arts (A.A.), Associate of Science (A.S.) and select Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S) degree programs</p> <p>Reverse Transfer Agreement gives students the opportunity to transfer coursework from Albright College to RACC to potentially earn an Associate's degree (enable eligible students to obtain an additional academic credential).</p> <p>Albright College School of Professional Studies - the Associate to Master's Degree agreement builds upon the previously established Guaranteed Transfer Admissions agreement for all students who earn a Reading Area Community College A.A., A.S., or A.A.S. degree</p>
Alvernia University	dual admissions; graduate from RACC in an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Applied Science or Associate of General Studies. All credits in programs listed in the agreement will fulfill general education, elective, or major requirements in the corresponding Alvernia major.
Arizona State University	Guaranteed general admission to ASU and admission into major of choice if all requirements are satisfied. Universal Articulation at Arizona State University gives students attending partnering community colleges access to ASU's transfer tools, in order to help create a seamless transition to ASU and enable students to successfully complete their bachelor's degree.
Boise State University	pathway: AAS in Respiratory Care to BS in Respiratory Care
Bucknell University	pathway: AS Engineering to BS in one of BU's Engineering Degrees (Bucknell Community College Scholars Program)
Chamberlain University	pathway: RN to BSN; online
Chestnut Hill College	Dual admissions and core-to-core transfer agreement: traditional day programs and accelerated adult degree evening programs; Graduate from RACC with an AA, AAS or AS in specified programs.
Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania	Students who apply for transfer admission to and graduate from RACC are guaranteed admission to Commonwealth University with at least full junior standing in Commonwealth University's parallel major.
DeSales University	core to core agreement applies to students who have completed a RACC associate degree (AA or AS)

Drexel University	<p>Pathway: Online RN to BSN</p> <p>Beginning in fall 2023, The Drexel Promise will provide students who have earned an associate degree at an accredited community college in either Pennsylvania or New Jersey with a renewable scholarship for 50% of the cost of tuition as they work to complete their bachelor's degree as a Drexel Dragon.</p>
Eastern University	<p>dual admissions: to facilitate the seamless transfer of qualifying RACC students who have earned the AA, AS, or AAS degree in an eligible program</p>
Elizabethtown College	<p>dual admissions; RACC students can pursue their bachelor's degree through seamless enrollment from an associate degree program at RACC</p> <p>School of Graduate and Professional Studies (SGPS): earned associate degree to an accelerated online bachelor degree program.</p>
George Washington University	<p>Students who have successfully completed an associate degree from RACC who desire to obtain a BSHS or a dual BSHS and MSHS from GW (Health Science): MLT to MLS option</p>
Harcum College	<p>pathway designed to help prepare RACC students for the competitive admission to the Occupational Therapy Assistant Program</p> <p>pathway designed to help prepare RACC students for the competitive admission to the Physical Therapy Assistant Program</p>
Immaculata University	<p>dual admissions; to facilitate the transfer of RACC graduates with an appropriate AA, AS, AAS, or AGS to Immaculata's Baccalaureate Degree Programs</p>

Susquehanna University	dual admissions; core to core; AA and AS program to parallel program at SU (some majors have specific requirements)
Temple University	dual admissions; List of AA and AS transfer degrees, gen ed to gen ed (core to core)
