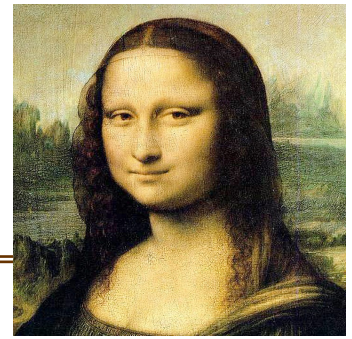

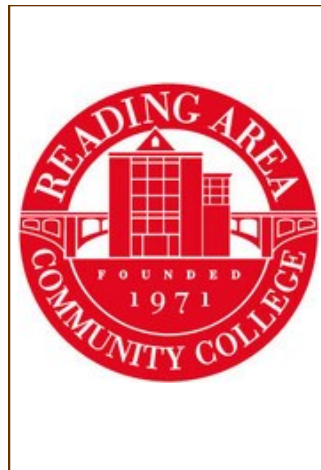

Print Books & E-Books

The [Yocum Library](#) has hundreds of print books on the fine arts that you can check out of the library. Subjects include but are not limited to “Visual Arts,” “Architecture,” “Sculpture,” and “Painting.” Titles include *Rodin’s Art*, *Becoming Mona Lisa*, *Chinese Painting*, and *Salvador Dali*. If you want to browse the collection on floor 3, the call numbers range from N through NX.



Print books circulate for four weeks and can be renewed if not requested by others.

Fine Art Magazines, floor 3

The Yocum Library subscribes to several fine art magazines, including *Art in America*, *Cloth Paper Scissors*, and *Veranda*. Current issues are displayed on floor 3

opposite the popular magazine display. Back issues are shelved in boxes behind the popular magazine display and can be checked out.

also contains the holdings of the Berks County Public Libraries.

College libraries have a collection of print books that are used just in the library. These books are called the “reference” or “research” collection. The Yocum Library research collection of fine art books is on floor 2 near the Research Librarians’ offices. Titles include *Encyclopedia of World Art*, *Modern Arts Criticism*, and *Dictionary of Women Artists*. Our collection also includes 800+ E-Books under “Arts and Architecture” in

EBSCOhost’s E-Books. *A Real Van Gogh*, *Architecture as Revolution*, and *Art for the Middle Classes* are some of the titles.

The Yocum Library holds five years of each title. Copies of these magazines can be made using the document scanning station on floor 2.

Next to the reference collection are the fine art DVDs. Call numbers range from N through NX. Titles include *Vatican Museums, Pablo Picasso, Frida Kahlo, and Frank Lloyd Wright.*

READING PUBLIC MUSEUM passes
