

Reading Area Community College Library Access to Library Services and Resources Policy

The Reading Area Community College (RACC) Library is open to the public although some library areas are reserved for RACC students, staff, and faculty. Children who are not participating in a RACC program must always be supervised by an accompanying adult while they are in the library. Violations of the RACC Student Code of Conduct and / or the Yocum Library Standards of Behavior Policy may result in removal from the library and / or the RACC campus.

Photocopiers, computers, printers, and Wi-Fi are available only to current RACC students, staff, faculty, trustees, and emeriti. FAX services are only available to current RACC staff and faculty. There are no color printing services available. There are no public telephones. The touchscreen scanner is available for all patrons to use.

Only current RACC students, staff, faculty, trustees, and emeriti have access to online licensed streaming services, online databases, ebooks, and online periodicals content. Only current RACC students, staff, faculty, trustees, and emeriti have access to interlibrary loan services.

RACC Library accounts are only created for current RACC students, staff, faculty, trustees, and emeriti. The RACC Library partners with the Berks County Public Libraries (BCPL) and shares a common library card system so BCPL adult and juvenile patrons may borrow RACC Library's physical books, films, and print magazines that are in the circulating collection. Only adult BCPL adult patrons can borrow RACC Library's Admission Passes and Library of Things. Only current RACC students, staff, and faculty may borrow items from the Reserves collection.

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
