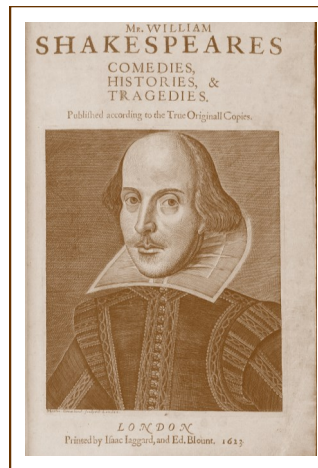
Books in the Circulating Collection, floor 3
