Reading Area Community College (RACC) partners with the Reading School District to offer the College Knights Program. The purpose of the College Knights Program is to provide seniors an early start on a college experience. College Knights are both high school students and college students.

Selected students will have the opportunity to take up to four (4) courses (two each semester) agreed upon by RACC and the Reading School District during the 2024-2025 school year.

Benefits from being part of the College Knights Program:

- Students will still take their necessary classes towards high school graduation.
- Students will learn from a college professor.
- Reading School District will pay for tuition and fees for courses as part of the Reading College Knights Program.
- Credits can be used towards an associate degree at RACC, which we hope you will consider or transferred to another college or university.

Student Access to MyRACC Portal: Students can access their RACC record by logging into the MyRACC portal on RACC's website. Students receive their student ID during course registration. Students will access their RACC course in the portal through Canvas, RACC's learning management system.

Request Transcripts in June of Graduating Year: To request that an official college transcript be sent, the student must use the online request form located on the RACC website – www.racc.edu/services/transcript-request. Students will need their RACC student ID number in order to request a transcript. It's the student's responsibility to verify the transfer credit policy at the college they wish to attend to find out how credits will be accepted.
