# **Admissions Requirements and Recommendations**

#### **Advising Notes:**

- 1. Students planning to finish a bachelor degree must complete three (3) credits of United States Cultures (US) and three (3) credits of International Cultures (IL) as part of the General Education requirements. Courses marked as US or IL will fulfill those requirements.
- 2. Certain majors require foreign language. Please speak to an advisor before scheduling.

#### Admissions Requirements:

- 1. To qualify as a transfer student, students must attempt a minimum of 18 credits.
- 2. Students are required to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale). <u>GPAs are recalculated to include all courses and grades, including all repeated courses.</u> Many majors have GPA requirements above 2.0.
- 3. A grade of C or better must be scored for a course to be reviewed for transfer.
- 4. Some majors at Penn State do NOT accept transfer students.
- 5. Some majors require that certain classes be taken before transferring to Penn State.
- 6. Please check with Penn State Berks Admissions for specific requirements for your major.
