

COLLEGE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

The Altrusa Club of Reading-Berks is an international service organization of volunteers dedicated to community service. Our goal, as members of our club, is to help improve the quality of life of individuals (both youth and adult) and families within Berks County. We are specifically interested in the areas of **literacy**, **leadership development, health and well-being**, and the **environment**. We accomplish our goals through hands-on service projects as well as through providing monetary contributions to individuals, agencies and organizations whose mission and goals are similar to ours.

In June of each school year, two deserving Berks County students attending an area college will be awarded financial aid in an amount to be determined each year. The amount is contingent on the amount of dollars raised by club members through our fund raising activities and is generally in the amount of \$1,000 to \$2,500 each year. This year we are pleased to announce we will be awarding a **\$2,500 scholarship to each** student chosen by our club. All recipients must be Berks County residents who plan to attend a Berks County educational institution of higher learning. All awarded scholarship funds will be sent directly to the school of choice in the student's name.

College student recipients must have maintained a 3.0 GPA or better and demonstrate financial need. Also required is a letter of recommendation by a faculty member or school official highlighting your participation in service activities and your need for financial assistance and their contact phone number. The deadline for submission must be post marked no later than March 15, 2024. The address for submission is on the second page of this application.
