Reading Area Community College (RACC) and La Salle University have created a Program-to-Program Transfer Agreement for the Social Work Major at RACC to the Social Work major at La Salle. To qualify, students will need to fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Apply to La Salle before earning 45 credits at RACC. Once students apply, they will need to send an official copy of their transcript for our evaluation.
- 2. Students must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA to qualify for admission to La Salle's Social Work program. Students who graduate with a GPA lower than our requirement may be denied admission to the program.
- 3. Students must graduate from RACC with their AA in Social Work to be eligible for this agreement.
- 4. Under the terms of the core-to-core agreement, the CORE at La Salle will essentially be satisfied by the CORE at RACC as long as the student has their AA in Social Work. In order to meet all requirements of La Salle's Core, students must take CORE qualifiers which will be: (1) Religion and (1) Philosophy if not already taken at RACC. All other CORE courses at La Salle will be fulfilled
- 5. This agreement stands for the full-time day program at the main campus, the evening and weekend program on the main campus or the accelerated program at the Metroplex.
- 6. Academic scholarships will be available to Full-time day students ONLY.
